Apart from the very different look of a stable door, the opening upper leaf can provide both sight and ventilation, while keeping the lower leaf closed to prevent children or animals leaving the home.


On a pleasant summer's day, one can well imagine the pleasure of looking out of the door and smelling the air while leaning on the rail of the lower leaf, and just passing the time...bliss!

The Stable Door we offer is not, as so often is the case, a Cottage door that has been cut to form the upper and lower portions of the Stable door.

This is the genuine article: constructed specifically with a mid-rail so that when cut through, it forms two leafs. Each leaf is completely surrounded by a rigid subframe providing stability and security, as well as weather protection.

The hardware that is used has been tested thoroughly for suitability of purpose, such that the locks, rack bolt (that joins the two halves), and rebate forming extrusions and rain deflectors, have been specifically designed.

A variety of colours are available as are glazing options. Something different and a bit special.... and worth thinking about.









Solid Doors







We offer triple glazed units, for high performance heat and sound insulation, and with the choice of toughened glass outer panes, laminated glass for extra strength, and Low E glass to improve energy rating.

Our only glass design that is double, as opposed to triple, glazed is Sulu, a resin bevel design that cannot be triple glazed.

So why do we offer triple glazing when so many other companies still offer just double glazing? Sound and heat insulation performance are important but triple glazing also protects the decorative centre pane. It prevents oxidisation of the lead caming and keeps intricate glass designs clean and dust free. A wipe over the smooth glass outer panes is all it takes to keep your decorative glass clean and sparkling.



The units are manufactured to EN1279 standard.

Care and Maintenance of your Composite Door

Your new insulated composite door is strong, durable and secure, and manufactured to an exacting and high quality specification. It's strength comes from the construction of its sub-frame in solid, water-resistant polymer material, reinforced behind with Laminated Veneered Lumber (LVL). The thermoset GRP skins are then bonded to this sub frame, and its core filled with high density, 100% CFC-free polyurethane foam.

The thermoset GRP skins are depression moulded featuring a lifelike grain effect and high definition panels providing an authentic timber like door with all the advantages but limited maintenance. Thermoset GRP cannot expand or contract laterally such that the door cannot increase or decrease in size, an advantage over other commonly used materials.

The factory finish colours of White, Black, Blue, Green and Red have pre-pigmented GRP skins which are over-sprayed with a UV stable paint.

The doors' insulation properties are excellent in both sound reduction and heat retention. In the case of sound this is particularly helpful in reducing traffic noise, with its high level of thermal insulation, outperforms both timber and PVC-u doors. This insulation contributes to the general energy efficiency of your home, and savings to your bills.

This insulated composite door is environmentally friendly as it rates low in both Global Warming Potential and Ozone Depletion.

Customer care and maintenance of your insulated composite door

To prolong the life of the surface finish and protect your warranty, it is recommended that your door is regularly cleaned by washing with warm soapy water (washing up liquid is suitable) using a soft, lint free cloth. Cleaning may need to be more frequent if your location is coastal, heavily industrialised or near a main road.

Important - do not:

- Use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads on the surface of the door
- · Use high pressure or steam cleaners
- Use any type of bleach, solvent (eg white spirit, methylated spirit, cellulose thinners or acetone/nail varnish remover)
- Use adhesives of any type or tack for providing temporary protection or fixing of seasonal or other decorations etc.
